The Afghan community has around population of 30,000 people in the Bay Area, and is spreading mostly in places like Fremont, Newark, Hayward, and Union City. The Bay Area contains the biggest overseas Afghan Diaspo-

ra community. A year ago in 2012, pastor Abrahim from Canada started his ministry to serve the Afghan people in Fremont and nearby areas (table 9). He has also been a pastor in an Afghan church for about 10 years in New Deli, India. Even in Fremont, his ministry is still challenged with threats and enormous tensions from Muslim Afghans as he shares the gospel to them. He had two converts and has started an Afghan church with worship with the converts and their family members at New Life Church in Fremont. Please, pray for him and support the first Afghan church in Nor Cal so that it may become the source of many blessings for Afghanistan and Muslims around the world!



The majority of Afghans living in the Bay Area are widows and thus are an important evangelism group to reach. However, according to Afghan custom, it is impos-



sible for a man to speak to a woman that he has seen for the first time. Thus, Pastor Abrahim sought to bring his wife and daughters from Canada, but was stopped by the lack of proof of a marriage certificate. However, the Afghan Consulate in LA issued a marriage certificate and thus it has been sent to the Immigrations Office.

The Afghan evangelism continues to partner with the New Life Church witness team and also the All Nations Ministry.

Prayer Requests:

- 1) That Kahn's faith would increase and that Kahn would be able to receive a baptism. And also that the three sons and daughter in laws would also receive the gospel
- 2) That Pastor Abraham's family would be able to receive Permanent Residency
- 3) That the application of Habibah's younger brothers and family in Pakistan for refugee status in the US would be granted.
- 4) That the Afghan men and women who heard the gospel would quickly receive Christ.
