When I planned the VBS for the Mongolian kids, I was informed that we would have about 20 or so kids and the VBS is totally strange to them and their parents. As we prayed with the information, we came to think that the VBS may be the last time for us to share the gospel with the kids. We had seriousness and enthusiasm as time went by. In the VBS camp we had a language issue when we divide the kids into small groups.

There were kids who only can understand Mongolian language. We had to make a separate group for them with a translator from English to Mongolian language. We made four stations (Bible study, craft, praise dance, game) for the kids to turn around each station in 20 minutes. After station time, we asked the kids to prepare for skits to express what they learned in the Bible study. The Kids were so much involved and greatly liked it.

We took a hike with kids around the trail of 1 and half hour long walk. It may be very hard for the kids but they endured surprisingly the hardship of hiking as kids and finished it with helping each other. It was a moving moment for us to see the Mongolian kids' wonderful enduring spirit.

After dinner, we had a presentation session for the parents to see their kids in VBS. The Mongolian parents appreciated what they saw from their kids and they strongly wanted to be volunteers next time. It was just one-day program but the teachers and leaders were touched in their hearts as they served the Mongolian kids in their living boundaries. Here is a brief letter from a volunteer (Mi Lee).....

My experience as a Crafts teacher at Mongolian VBS was such a precious experience. I was so blessed to have an opportunity to share bible verses and spend quality time with such beautiful kids. I pray that these kids will grow into beautiful soldiers who will wear God's weapons to stand strong against any hardships they will face as they grow up.
